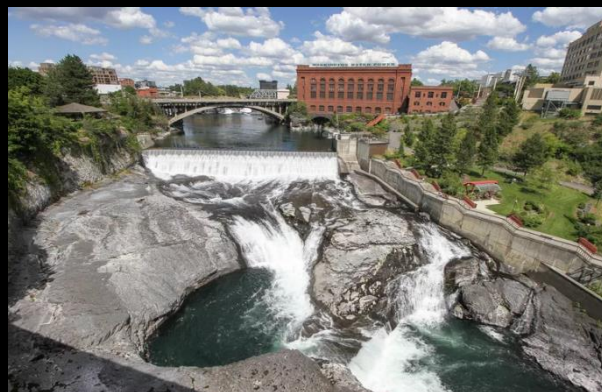


International Homicide Investigators Association Basic Homicide Investigation Course
