

Staff Lieutenant Jason Shea

Jason Shea has served with the Texas Department of Public Safety for 27 years. He began his career in 1998 after graduating from the DPS Recruit School and was assigned to the Texas Highway Patrol. In 2006, he was promoted to Highway Patrol Sergeant, overseeing Troopers across four counties.

In 2013, Lieutenant Shea advanced to the Texas Ranger Division, where he conducted complex investigations ranging from homicides to multi-million-dollar embezzlements. In 2016, he was assigned to the Texas Ranger Special Response Team, where he participated in high-risk warrant arrests and was deployed to the Texas-Mexico border to conduct border security operations. In 2022, Jason joined the Texas Ranger UCIP (Unsolved Crimes Investigation Program), focusing on cold case investigations. In 2023, he transitioned to the Texas Ranger SAKI Program (Sexual Assault Kit Initiative – Cold Case Investigations and Prosecution), where he investigates cold case sexual assaults and homicides utilizing advanced DNA technology. In 2025, Jason was promoted to Staff Lieutenant, where he supervises UCIP Rangers and serves as the coordinator for the Texas Ranger SAKI Cold Case Investigations and Prosecution Program.
